

ORDINANCE NO. 37.

AN ORDINANCE ESTIMATING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE ENSUING YEAR.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, does by this Ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for the ensuing year 1918 to be \$1393.00.

SECTION II

That the purposes for which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which is hereby made a part of this Ordinance:

Fuel and Upkeep for the Town Hall	\$ 5.00
Expenditures of Recorder's Office	25.00
Elections - - - - -	25.00
Treasurer's Commission - - - - -	35.00
Marshal's Salary - - - - -	120.00
Interest on Outstanding Warrants	30.00
Electric Lights - - - - -	440.00
Miscellaneous Items - - - - -	50.00
Miscellaneous streets, crosswalks, bridges and so forth - - - - -	663.00
Total - - - - -	\$1393.00

SECTION III

That in order to raise a sufficient fund to meet expenditures as shown by the foregoing it is hereby ordered that a ten mill general fund tax on all property, both real and personal, which is taxable by law for state and county purposes, be levied.
