ORDINANCE No. 38.

An Ordinance licensing certain business and employment in the Town of Sherwood, and regulating the manner of issuing said license.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or joint stock company to engage in or carry on any of the business, trade or employment without first obtaining a license to do so.

SECTION II.

That every person, firm, corporation or company requiring by any ordinance to obtain a license to engage in any trade, business or profession for which a license is required shall pay to the Town Treasurer the sum or sums required by ordinance to be paid therefor; thereupon, with the receipt of the Town Treasurer (which receipt shall set forth the kind of business for which license is desired), they shall apply to the Recorder of the Town of Sherwood, who shall issue the license to the parties applying in accordance with the receipt of the Treasurer

SECTION III.

That in every license to be taken out under and by virtue of this ordinance, shall be contained and set forth the purpose, trade, business or profession for which such license is granted, and the name and place of business of the person or persons taking out the same; and said license shall authorize the continuance of the business named therein at the place named therein for the term of such license.

SECTION IV.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain and conduct what is commonly known as a poolhall or a billiardhall within the Town of Sherwood shall pay a license according to the number of pool or billiard tables belonging to or used in the building or place to be licensed. For each and every table contained in said pool or billiard hall the keeper thereof shall pay an annual license fee of \$7.50 payable quarterly in advance. Every place where pool or billiards is played when a charge is made by the owner or the proprietor thereof to persons playing pool or billiards shall be regulated

SECTION V.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain and conduct any place of business within the Town of Sherwood and maintain therein tables used for card-playing shall pay an annual license fee of \$ 7.50 payable quarterly in advance, for each table used and maintained therein for card playing.

SECTION VI.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain and operate what is known as a Dray for hauling and moving within the Town of Sherwood shall pay an annual license fee of \$ 10.00 payable semi-annually, for each and every Dray so maintained.

SECTION VII.

~~Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain or conduct any public dance or dance hall within the Town of Sherwood, shall pay a quarterly license fee of \$ 12.00 in advance for each and every of said public dance or dance halls maintained.~~

SECTION VIII.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain or conduct any Picture Show and Vaudaville Shows within the Town of Sherwood shall pay an annual license fee of \$ 25.00 for such Picture Show and Vaudaville Show maintained or conducted. *Repealed by Ordinance #124.*

SECTION IX.

Every manager or proprietor of every traveling show or circus visiting the Town of Sherwood for the purpose of giving performance shall pay a license fee of \$ 2.50 per day.

SECTION X.

That any person, firm, company or corporation wishing to sell, or offer for sale, any article of merchandise from a stand or wagon, or on any of the streets or public grounds within the limits of the Town of Sherwood shall first pay a license fee of \$ 2.50 per day and obtain a permit in writing signed by both the Mayor and Marshall of said Town. The Mayor shall have power to refuse to sign or grant said permit without assigning any reason therefore.

S E C T I O N XI.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Town Court, be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 Ten Dollars, nor more than (\$50.00) Fifty Dollars, or by imprisonment of not to exceed twenty five (25) days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

S E C T I O N XII.

Inasmuch as Ordinance No. 21 and No. 24 pertaining to licensing various occupations and business is inadequate, and does not subserve the best interests of the inhabitants of the Town of Sherwood, this Ordinance shall be of full force and effect upon its passage by the Council and approval by the mayor.

S E C T I O N XIII.

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance is, and the same is hereby repealed.
