

ORDINANCE No. 39

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That pursuant to an act passed by the Twenty-Ninth regular session of the Legislative Assembly of 1917, amending the Constitution of the State of Oregon in the matter of Incorporated Cities and Towns holding their nominating and regular elections for their several elective officers at the same time that primary and general biennial elections for State and County officers are held, it is hereby resolved

SECTION II.

By the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood that Ordinance No. 15, and that portion of section five (5) of the town charter pertaining to time of holding the annual town election, is, and the same is hereby abrogated, and that the annual election of the Town of Sherwood shall be held hereafter at the biennial election for state and county officers. And by virtue of said legislative act, the present officers of the Town of Sherwood shall hold their respective office until their successors are elected and qualified.

SECTION III.

Inasmuch as the annual election of the Town of Sherwood falls on the second Monday of December, and the Town of Sherwood is required to enact supplementary legislation in carrying out the provisions of said legislative act, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
