

ORDINANCE No. 41

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, does by this Ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for ensuing year of 1919 to be \$1270.00, and that the amount to be received during the year from various items to be \$225.00, leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax of \$1045.00.

Following is

SECTION II.

That the purpose for which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which has been posted and published according to law:

The recorder is hereby authorised to transmit an exact copy of said budget to the County Assessor, of Washington County, Oregon, that same may be properly extend on the assessment rolls for year of 1919.
