

ORDINANCE No. 42

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Washington County Oregon, does by this Ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1920 to be \$1350.00, and that the amount to be received during the year from various items to be \$150.00, leaving a balance to be raised by general tax of \$1200.00.

SECTION II.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which has been posted and published according to law:
