ORDINANCE No. 46 Ordinance 64-536

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACCUMULATION OF GARBAGE AND OTHER REFUSE.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

S E C T I O N I.

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, firm, company or corporation, to throw or deposit in any street, alley, sidewalk or other public place within the Town of Sherwood, any garbage, refuse or filth of any kind.

S E C T I O N II.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction before the Town Recorder, be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.00, or in case of default of payment of such fine, be imprisoned in the town jail not less than one day nor more than 10 days.

S E C T I O N III.

The town of Sherwood not having any ordinance prohibiting the accumulation of garbage and other refuse, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
