

AN ORDINANCE granting to the STANDARD OIL COMPANY, a California corporation, permission and authority to locate, erect, maintain and operate warehouse or warehouses, storage tanks and other necessary buildings and appurtenances, together with all necessary pipelines and conduits on that certain tract of land in the City of Sherwood, County of Washington, State of Oregon----- described as follows:

Beginning at Station 902 plus 48.0 of the Southern Pacific Company's Main line track at Sherwood, Ore., thence North Westerly at right angles to said main line 64.6' to the true point of beginning; thence continuing in the same line 95.4' to the North Westerly line of the Southern Pacific Company's right-of-way; thence at right angles South Westerly along said right-of-way line 150.0' thence South Easterly at right angles 95.4' to a point 64.6' from Station 903 plus 98.0 of Southern Pacific Company's main line; thence north easterly along a line parallel to the Southern Pacific Company's main line track 150' to the point of beginning.

for the storage and distribution of petroleum and its products, and all other kinds of merchandise produced by the said company.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Sherwood

SECTION 1. That the Standard Oil Company, a California corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the state of California and licensed to do business in the State of Oregon be and it is hereby granted permission and authority to locate, erect, maintain and operate a warehouse or warehouses, storage tanks and all other necessary buildings and appurtenances, together with pipe lines and conduits on and over above described property-----

for the storage and distribution of petroleum and its products and all other kinds of merchandise produced by said company.

SECTION 2. That the said proposed structures and improvements shall be erected and maintained with all proper safeguards and in conformity to the practices followed by said company at its various stations, and said improvements shall be maintained and conducted under the ordinances now existing.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the expiration of thirty days after its passage and publication or posting according to law.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
