

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I.

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1923, to be \$2116.50, and the amount to be received during the year from various sources to be \$150.00, leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax on all taxable property in the Town of Sherwood, the sum of \$1966.50.

SECTION II.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which has been posted and published according to law, and passed upon by the majority vote of the legal tax payers of the Town of Sherwood, assembled for said purpose on the 27th day of November, at 7:30 p.M.
