

O R D I N A N C E NO. 57

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

S E C T I O N - 1.

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1924, to be \$2,225.00, and the amount to be received during the year from various sources to be \$150.00, leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax on all taxable property in the Town of Sherwood, the sum of \$2,075.00.

S E C T I O N - 11.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget for which an exact copy of the Common Council sitting as a budget board is hereby attached:


S E C T I O N - 111.
