

ORDINANCE No 59

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1.

That the Common Council of the City of Sherwood, Washington, County, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the City of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1925, to be \$2355.00, and the amount to be received during the year from Various sources to be \$100.00 leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax on all taxable property in the City of Sherwood, the sum of \$2255.00.

SECTION - 11.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget for which and exact copy of the City Council sitting as a budget board is hereby attached:
