ORDINANCE No. 731.

An Ordinance for making street improvements on 3rd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southwesterly line (extended northwesterly,) of Pine Street to the southwesterly line (extended northwesterly) of Main Street, with street intersection improvements to the property line at Washington Street and at Main Street, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said street improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That 3rd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, be improved from the southwesterly line (extended northwesterly,) of Pine Street to the southwesterly line (extended northwesterly) of Main Street, with street intersection improvements to the property line at Washington Street and at Main Street, by bringing the surface of said 3rd Street to the proper subgrade, paving the roadway and said street intersections with macadam pavement of an approximate thickness of 0.7 feet, and of a width of 26 feet on the roadway and said intersections to the property line, laying and constructing concrete curb, (except where curb is already constructed,) driveways, concrete cornerstones at driveways, providing suitable drainage, and by doing such other improvement work as will make a proper and appropriate street improvement.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of such improvement work be assessed against the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon that part of said 3rd Street so improved, and upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land liable for said street intersection improvements, and that such work be done in the manner prescribed in this ordinance and as provided in the Charter of said City.

Section 3. That the City Engineer of said City be and he is hereby directed to estimate the whole cost and expense of said street improvement, as prescribed by the Charter of said City, and to report such estimate to this City Council.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health, peace and safety of said City, and it is necessary that the same be done without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
