

ORDINANCE No. 75..

An Ordinance for making street improvements on Park Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northwesterly line of Railroad Street to the northwesterly line (extended) of 2nd Street, with street intersection improvement at 1st Street, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Park Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, be improved from the northwesterly line of Railroad Street to the northwesterly line (extended) of 2nd Street, together with street intersection improvement at 1st Street, by bringing the surface of said portion of Park Street to the proper subgrade, paving the roadway with macadam pavement 26 feet wide, paving the street intersection at said 1st street, all of said pavement to be of an approximate thickness of 0.7 feet, laying and constructing concrete curb (except where curb is already constructed,) driveways, concrete cornerstones at driveways, providing suitable drainage, and by doing such other improvement work as will make a proper and appropriate street improvement.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of such improvement work be assessed against the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon said portion of Park Street so improved and upon the lots, tracts or parcels of land liable for the cost of said street intersection, and that such work be done in the manner prescribed in this ordinance and as provided by the charter of said City.

Section 3. That the City Engineer of said City be and he is hereby directed to estimate the whole cost and expense of said street improvement, as prescribed by the Charter of said City, and to report such estimate to this City Council.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health, peace and safety of said City, and it is necessary that the same be done without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
