

ORDINANCE NO 77

An Ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 66 of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood, Oregon, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That ordinance No. 66 of the City of Sherwood, Oregon entitled "An ordinance for making street improvements on Pine Street in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of Third Street to the northwesterly line of the right-of-way of the S.P. Railroad, together with all street intersections included in said street improvement, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency" passed by the City Council of said City and approved by the Mayor thereof on July 27, 1925, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public health, peace, and convenience and safety of said City, and it is necessary that the same be done without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
