ORDINANCE No. 19.

An Ordinance

An Ordinance declaring the advisability of improving Bine Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of 3rd Street to the northwesterly line of the right-of-way of the S. P. Railroad, together with all street intersections included in said street improvement, at the partial expense of the general fund of said City, designating the amount to be paid thereon ordering the payment thereof, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sharwood does ordain as follows:

Whether, Ithe City council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, has, by the adoption of Ordinance No. 2. of said City, passed and approved on July Cont. 1925, ordered the improvement of said Pine Street from the southeasterly line of 3rd Street to the northwesterly line of the right of way of the S. P. Railroad, together with street intersections included therein, such street improvement to be made of concrete pavement 20 feet wide and of an approximate thickness of six inches: And.

Whereas, said Pine Street, so to be improved, is a street within the limits of said City which directly connects with county roads and highways which lead into and out of said City and it provides the most accessible and generally travelled road from withinsaid City to beyond the City limits of said City upon the county roads with which it connects, and said City Council deems it advisable to construct such street improvement at the partial expense of the general fund of said City of Sherwood: And,

Whereas, the estimated costs of making said street improvement amounts to the sum of \$5803.44, and the City Council deems it advisable to pay \$3700.00 of said cost out of the general fund of said City, and to assess the remainder, viz: \$2403.44 of said cost against the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon said Pine Street, so improved, and liable therefor and liable for said street intersection improvements: Now, Therefore,

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That, as hereinbefore set out, the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, deems it advisable to improve said Pine Street, from the southeasterly line of 3rd Street to the northwesterly line of the right of way of the S. P. Railroad, together with street intersections therein, at the partial expense of the general fund of said City of Sherwood, and it is hereby ordered and ordained that \$3700.00 of the cost and expense of making said street improvement be paid out of the general fund of said City, and that the remainder of said cost, viz: \$2405 % be paid by assessment thereof against the property liable therefor and benefitted thereby, under the provisions of the Charter of said City.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, safety and convenience of said City that the said street improvement be made at the partial expense of the general fund of said City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor.
