

ORDINANCE No. 80...

An Ordinance declaring the advisability of improving Main Street from the northwesterly line of Railroad Street to the northwesterly line of 1st Street, and also said 1st Street from the northeasterly line of Main street to the southwesterly line of Pine Street, together with street intersection improvements included in said street improvement, at the partial expense of the general fund of said City, designating the amount to be paid thereon out of said general fund, ordering the payment thereof, and declaring an emergency.

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, has, by the adoption of Ordinance No. 69, of said City, passed and approved on July 27, 1925, ordered the improvement of said Main Street from the northwesterly line of Railroad Street to the northwesterly line of 1st Street, and also said 1st Street from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southwesterly line of Pine Street, together with street intersection improvements included in said street improvement, such street improvement to be made of concrete pavement 44 feet wide and of an approximate thickness of six inches, together with full street intersections also of concrete, together with concrete curbs, driveways, cornerstones at driveways, and providing suitable drainage; And,

Whereas, said Main Street and 1st Street, so improved, form a connected and continuous improvement within said City the limits of said City which directly connects with county roads and highways which lead into and out of said City and provide the most accessible and generally travelled road from within said City to beyond the City limits of said City upon the County roads with which they connect, and said City Council deems it advisable to construct such street improvement at the partial expense of the general fund of said City of Sherwood: And,

Whereas, the estimated cost of making such street improvement amounts to the sum of \$823.40, and the City Council deems it advisable to pay \$4300.00 of said cost out of the general fund of said City, and to assess the remainder, viz: \$523.40 of said cost against the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon said streets, so improved, and liable therefor and liable for said street intersection improvements:

Now, Therefore,

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That, as hereinbefore set out, the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, deems it advisable to improve said Main Street from the northwesterly line of Railroad Street to the northwesterly line of 1st Street, and also said 1st Street from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southwesterly line of Pine Street, together with street intersection improvements included in said street improvement, at the partial expense of the general fund of said City of Sherwood, and it is hereby ordered and ordained that \$4300.00 of the cost and expense of making said street improvement be paid out of the general fund of said City, and that the remainder of said ~~cost~~ cost, viz: \$523.40, be paid by assessment thereof against the property liable therefor and benefitted thereby, under the provisions of the Charter of said City.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, safety and convenience of said City that the said street improvements be made at the partial expense of the general fund of said City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor.
