ORDINANCE No. 82....

An Ordinance declaring and assessing upon each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon Washington Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, its proportionate share of the costs and expenses of the improvement of said Washington Street from said southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 68, of said City, entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on Washington Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, prescribing the character of material to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency,"

passed by the City Council of said City and approved by the Mayor thereof on July 27, 1925, and directing that the said assessed cost be entered in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the Charter of said City, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon Washington Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, be and the same is hereby assessed with its proportionate share of the estimated costs and expenses of the improvement of said Washington Street from the southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 68, of said City entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on Washington Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of 1st Street to the northwesterly line of Railroad Street, prescribing the character of material to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency,"

passed by the City Council of said City, and approved by the Mayor thereof, on July 27, 1925, and as apportioned by the City Council, as follows:

Section 2. That the Recorder of said City be and he is hereby directed to enter a statement of the said assessed costs of said street improvement in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided in the Charter thereof.

Section 3. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health, peace and safety of said City, and that it is necessary that the same be done and the costs and expenses thereof be assessed and collected without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, this ordinance shall be in effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
