

ORDINANCE No. 85..

An Ordinance declaring and assessing upon each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon Main Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northwesterly line of 1st Street to the southeasterly line of 3rd Street, and upon each lot, tract or parcel of land subject to assessment for the cost of improving the intersection of said Main Street with Second Street, in said City, its proportionate share of the costs and expenses of the improvement of the above described portion of said Main Street, and said intersection, as provided by Ordinance No.... of said City, entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on Main Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northwesterly line of 1st Street to the southeasterly line of 3rd Street, including improvement of full intersection at said Main Street and Second Street, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency,"

passed by the City Council of said City and approved by the Mayor thereof on July 27, 1925, and directing that the said assessed cost be entered in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the Charter of said City, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon Main Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northwesterly line of 1st Street to the southeasterly line of 3rd Street, and also each lot, tract or parcel of land subject to assessment for the cost of improving the intersection of said Main Street with Second Street, in said City, be and the same is hereby assessed with its proportionate share of the estimated costs and expenses of the improvement of said Main Street from the northwesterly line of 1st Street to the southeasterly line of 3rd Street, and also for the cost of improving the intersection at said Main and Second Streets, as provided by Ordinance No. 72 of said City, entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on Main Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northwesterly line of 1st Street to the southeasterly line of 3rd Street, including improvement of full intersection at said Main Street and Second Street, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency,"

passed by the City Council of said City, and approved by the Mayor thereof, on July 27, 1925, and as apportioned by the City Council, as follows:

Section 2. That the Recorder of said City be and he is hereby directed to enter a statement of the said assessed costs of said street improvement in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided in the Charter thereof

Section 3. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health, peace and safety of said City, and that it is necessary that the same be done and the costs and expenses thereof be assessed and collected without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
