

ORDINANCE No. 97

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

SECTION 1.

That the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the the estimate of expenditures for operating the City of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1926, to be \$2540.00, and the amount to be received from all sources for the year of 1926 to be \$150.00, leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax on all taxable property within the City of Sherwood, the sum of \$2390.00.

SECTION 11.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget for which an exact copy of the City Council sitting as a budget board is hereby attached;
