That the City Council of the City of Sherwood, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the City of Sherwood for the ensuing year of 1927, to be \$2650.00, and the amount to be received from all sources for the year of 1927 to be \$117.00, leaving a balance to be raised by a general tax on all taxable property within the City of Sherwood, the sum of \$2533.00.

SECTION II.

That the purpose of which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget for which an exact copy of of the City Council sitting as a budget board is hereby attached.
