ORDINANCE No. 102.

Ordinance prescribing penalties for intoxication, or drunkenness, on the streets, alleys, parks, or other public places in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, and defining what, for the purposes of this ordinance, be deemed public places, repealing all ordinances, and parts of ordinances, of said City, in conflict with this ordinance, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Any person who shall be intoxicated, or drunk, in or upon any street, alley, or in any park or other public place, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished as provided in Section 2 of this Ordinance. Provided, that all shops, stores, offices, halls, dance halls, churches, school buildings or grounds, schoolrooms, booths, tents, and any and all places of public assembly, or places where the public assembles, or is invited to go, for either business or pleasure, shall, for the purposes of this ordinance, be taken and deemed to be public places within the meaning of this ordinance.

P E N A L T Y .

Section 2. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not more than Fifty Days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

R E P E A L .

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, insofar as any conflict may exist.

E M E R G E N C Y .

Section 4. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the public health, peace and safety of said City that adequate provisions be made for the prevention and punishment of intoxication or drunkenness therein, without further delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor.
