ORDINANCE No. 105

An Ordinance prescribing licenses for hawkers, peddlers, hucksters, pool, whalls, billiard halls, card halls or places used for card playing. We dance halls, shows, theatrical performances prescribing penalties for the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, repealing Ordinance No. 38 of the Town (now City) of Sherwoor, Oregon, and all other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. (LICENSES REQUIRED.)

It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, company, firm, corporation, partnership or other association of persons, to engage in, maintain, conduct or carry on, either as principal or agent, within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, the business, trade, calling or occupation of hawker, peddler, or huckster, or to open, keep, maintain, or conduct any pool hall, billiard hall or place where pool, billiards, or any similar games are played, or any hall or place used for card playing, or any dance hall, for any show, or similar place of amusement, without having first having obtained a license therefor, as hereinafter in this ordinance prescribed.

Section 2. That any person, persons, company, firm, corporation partnership or other association of persons wishing to sell, or offer for sale, any article of goods, wares or merchandise, from a stand, or from any vehicle on any street or any public ground, or wishing to sell from house to house, all within the limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall first pay a license fee of \$2.50 per day and obtain the license prescribed in Section 1 of this ordinance. Provided: That orders taken for future delivery shall be deemed peddling, within the meaning of this ordinance. And, provided, further, that this ordinance shall not apply to persons selling goods or products of their own manufacture or production, nor to salesmen or commercial travellers taking orders from local merchants for goods, wares and merchandise to be resold in course of trade.

Section 3. That any person, firm, company, corporation or other association of persons who shall keep, maintain, open, keep open, conduct or operate, within the corporate limits of said City of Sherwood, Oregon, what is commonly known or designated as a pool hall, or a billiard hall, shall pay a license according to the number of pool tables or billiard tables belonging to, kept or used in the building or place, which rate of license shall be as follows: For each and every such table contained in said place an annual license fee of \$/000 payable quarterly, in advance. Every person, firm, company, corporation or other association of persons, who shall keep, maintain, keep open, conduct or operate any hall or place used for card playing, or where card games are played where a charge is made therefor by the owner or proprietor, shall pay an annual license fee of \$/000 payable quarterly, in advance. Provided: that each and every place where pool or billiards are played when a charge is made by the owner or proprietor, or other person in charge, for the privilege thereof shall be regarded as a pool hall or billiard hall under this ordinance.

Section 4. (Dance Halls)

Any person, firm, company, or any association of persons, who shall maintain or conduct any public dance or dance hall, within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall pay a license fee of \$2.50, in advance for each and every of said dances of dance halls maintained; provided a quarterly license fee of \$12.50, in advance is not desired.

Section 5. (Shows.)

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain or conduct any picture show or vaudeville show within the City of Therwood, Oregon, shall first pay an annual licesse fee of \$25.00 for such picture show or vaudeville show so maintained or conducted. Provided, that entertainments given by local talent and for public or charitable purposes shall not be required to pay any licesse fee under this ordinance

Section 6. (Travelling shows, Circus shows, Wrestling and Boxing bouts)

Every manager or proprietor of every travelling show, circus, wrestling or boxing bouts (matches) visiting the City of Sherwood, Oregon, for the purpose of giving performances shall pay a license fee of \$2.50 per day, in advance.

Section 7. (Manner of Procuring Licenses.)

That every person, firm corporation, company or association required by any ordinance of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, to obtain a license to engage in any trade, business, or any other avtivity for which a license is required, shall pay to the Recorder of said City the prescribed license fee therefor, and said Recorder shall thereupon issue the license to the party applying therefor. Such license shall set forth the purpose, trade, business or activity in which the licensee is licensed to engage in, and for which such license is granted, the name and place of business of the licensee, together with the period of time for which issued, which license shall authorize the licensee to engage in such activity for and during the time covered by such license.

Section 8 (Penalties.)

Any person, or persons, company, firm, corporation, or assiciation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail of said City of Sherwwod, Oregon, not to exceed fifty days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 9. (Repealing Provisions.)

That Ordinance No. 38 of the Town of Fherwood, Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance licensing certain business and employment in the Town of Fherwood, and regulating the manner of issuing said license," passed and approved on December 7, 1917, and all other ordinances, and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 10. (Emergency clause.)

Inasmuch as the City of Sherwood, Oregon, does not have adequate provisions in force for licensing the various things mentioned herein, and that it is necessary for the health, peace and safety of said City that such provisions be made and enforced, without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 105

An Ordinance prescribing licenses for hawkers, peddlers, hucksters, pool halls, billiard halls, card halls or places used for card playing, dance halls, shows, theatrical performances, wrestling or boxing bouts, prescribing penalties for the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, repealing Ordinance No.38 of the Town (now City) of sherwood, Oregon, and all other ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, and delcaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section I (LICENSES REQUIRED)

 It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, company, firm, corporation, partnership or other association of persons, to engage in, maintain, conduct or carry on, either as principal or agent, within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, the business, trade, calling or occupation of hawker, peddler, or huckster, or to open, keep, maintain, or conduct any pool hall, billiard hall or place where pool, billiards, or any similar games are played, or any hall or place used for card playing, or any dance hall, wrestling or boxing houts, or any show, or similar place of amusement, without having first having obtained a license therefor, as hereinafter in this ordinance prescribed.

Section 2. (PEDDLERS)

That any person, persons, company, firm, corporation partnership or other association of persons wishing to sell, or offer for sale, any article of goods, wares or merchandise, from a stand, or from any vehicle on any street or any public ground, or wishing to sell from house to house, all within the limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall first pay a license fee of \$2.50 per day and obtain the license prescribed in Section I of this ordinance. Provided: That orders taken for future delivery shall be deemed peddling, within the meaning of this ordinance. And, provided, further, that this ordinance shall not apply to persons selling goods or products of their own manufacture or production, nor to salesmen or commercial travellers taking orders from local merchants for goods, wares and merchandise to be resold in course of trade.

Section 3. (POOL & BILLIARD TABLES and CARD TABLES)

That any person, firm, company, corporation or other association of persons who shall keep, maintain, open, keep open, conduct or operate, within the corporate limits of said City of Sherwood, Oregon, what is commonly known or designated as a pool hall, or a billiard hall, shall pay a license according to the number of pool tables or billiard tables belonging to, kept or used in the building or place, which rate of license shall be as follows: For each and every such table contained in said place an annual license fee of \$10.00 payable quarterly, in advance. Every person, firm, company, corporation or other association of persons, who shall keep, maintain, keep open, conduct or operate any hall or place used for card playing, or where card games are played where a charge is made therefor by the owner or proprietor, shall pay an annual license fee of \$10.00 payable quarterly, in advance. Provided: that each and every place where pool or billiards are played when a charge is made by the owner or proprietor or other person in charge, for the privilege thereof shall be regarded as a pool hall or billiard hall under this ordinance.

Section 4. (DANCE HALLS) This section reference by Buth de

Any person, firm, company, or any association of persons, who shall maintain or conduct any public dance or dance hall, within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall pay a license fee of \$2.50, in advance, for for each and every of said dances or dance halls maintained; provided a quarterly license fee of \$12.50, in advance is not desired.

Any person, firm, company or corporation who shall maintain or conduct any picture show or vaudeville show within the City of Sherwood, Oregon, shall first pay an annual license fee of \$25.00 for such picture show or vaudeville show so maintained or conducted. Provided, that entertainments given by local talent and for public or charitable purposes shall not be required to pay any license fee under this ordinance.

Section 6. (TRAVELLING SHOWS, CIRCUS SHOWS, WRESTLING AND BOXING BOUTS)

Every manager or proprietor of every travelling show, circus, wrestling or boxing bouts (matches) visiting the City of Sherwood, Oregon, for the purpose of giving performances shall pay a license fee of \$2.50 per day, in advance.

Section 7. (MANNER OF PROCURING LICENSES)

That every person, firm, corporation, company or association required by any ordinance of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, to obtain a license to engage in any trade, business, or any other activity for which a license is required, shall pay to the Recorder of said City the prescribed license fee therefor, and said Recorder shall thereupon issue the license to the party applying therefor. Such license shall set forth the purpose, trade, business or activity in which the licenses is licensed to engage in, and for which such license is granted, the name and place of business of the licensee, together with the period of time for which issued, which license shall authorize the licensee to engage in such activity for and during the time covered by such license.

Section 8 (PENALTIES)

Any person, or persons, company, firm, corporation, or association convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail of said City of Sherwood, Oregon, not to exceed fifty days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 9. (REPEALING PROVISIONS)

That Ordinance No. 38 of the Town of Sherwood, Oregon, entitled "An Ordinance licensing certain business and employment in the Town of Sherwood, and regulating the manner of issuing said License", passed and approved on December 7, 1917, and all other ordinances, and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 10. (EMERGENCY CLAUSE)

Inasmuch as the City of Sherwood, Oregon, does not have adduate provisions in force for licensing the various things mentioned herein, and that it is necessary for the health, peace and safety of said City that such provisions be made and enforced, without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinace shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor
