

ORDINANCE NO. 108

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS

Section 1.

That the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the City of Sherwood for the ensuing year 1930, to be \$3132.00; and the amount to be raised from various sources during the year 1930 to be \$132.00, leaving a balance to be raised from general taxation on all taxable property within The City of Sherwood, Oregon, the sum of \$3000.00.

Section 11.

That the purpose for which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which is an exact copy of the one adopted by the City Council sitting as a levying board:
