

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE TIME OF SALE AND DISPOSITION OF
INTOXICATING LIQUORS.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation licensed by the Town of Sherwood to sell intoxicating liquors and to conduct or maintain a saloon, barroom or drinking shop, shall in his or their saloon, barroom, drinking shop, or in any room, box, booth, stall or place connected therewith, sell, give, or offer to sell or give, any intoxicating liquors to any person or persons between the hours of 12:00 o'clock P. M. and 6:00 o'clock A. M., or between the hours of 12:00 o'clock P. M. Saturday and 6:00 A. M. Monday, and during the voting hours of any election day, or permit any person or persons to remain in such saloon, barroom, drinking shop, or in any room, box, booth, stall or place connected therewith, during such hours for the purpose of buying or drinking any vinous, spiritous or malt liquors or beverages.

(PENALTY).

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before the Town Court shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$25.00, or punished by imprisonment of not less than 5 days nor more than 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ days, or both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

(EMERGENCY)

Section 3. Whereas, there is an immediate necessity that this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the Town of Sherwood for the following reasons:

That the said Town of Sherwood is at present without any written ordinance pertaining to the time of sale and disposition of intoxicating liquors; that such ordinances heretofore enacted and the record of same have been destroyed by fire; that it is necessary to provide regulations for the time of sale and disposition of intoxicating liquors therein;

THEREFORE, This ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the President of the Council.
