

ORDINANCE NO. 6.

AN ORDINANCE TO ENFORCE THE CONNECTION OF PRIVIES
AND CESSPOOLS WITH THE TOWN SEWER.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That any person, firm or corporation who owns or has control of any privy or cesspool within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood, which is used as a receptacle for waste matters, and which said privy or cesspool is within 120 feet of the pipe or pipes of the town sewer, such person, firm or corporation shall, before the first day of May, 1914, connect or cause to be connected such privy or cesspool with the town sewer in such manner as the Town Council may direct.

Section 2. If any such person, firm or corporation shall fail, neglect or refuse to connect such privy or cesspool with the town sewer, as above provided, the Town Council may connect or cause to be connected such privy or cesspool with the town sewer, and the expenses of same shall be assessed against and become a lien upon such property upon which such privy or cesspool is located; and the Town Council shall have authority to enforce the collection of such lien or liens in the same manner as provided by law for the enforcement of town liens.
