

ORDINANCE NO. 18

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF SCREENS  
OR CURTAINS IN BARROOMS.

\*\*\*

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

That the window or windows in any building or buildings in which there is conducted any saloon, barroom or drinking shop, within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood, shall not be obstructed by any curtain or screen, or any other object or thing, so that the bar of said saloon, barroom or drinking shop shall be concealed from any person or persons, on the outside of said building or buildings, looking through said window or windows.

(PENALTY)

Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction before the Town Court, be fined not less than \$10.00 for each and every day the said window or windows in said building or buildings be obstructed, or the bar of said saloon, barroom or drinking shop be concealed from view.
