ORDINANCE # 63.

An Ordinance empowering and authorizing the President of the Council and the Recorder of the Town of Sherwood, Oregon, to execute a contract with the Tualatin Valley Electric Company an Oregon corporation, its successors or assigns, for the purchase of electric current for lighting or other purposes for the period of ten years.

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the President of the Council and the Town
Recorder of the Town of Sherwood be and they are hereby authorized
empowered and directed to enter into, sign, and execute for and on
begalf of the Said Tawn of Sherwood, a written contract of words
and figures as follows, to-wit:

This agreement, Made and entered into this 4th day of April 1913. by and between the Town of Sherwood, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, hereinafter referred to and designated as the party of the first part, and the Tualatin Valley Electric Company, of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, hereinafter referred to and designated as the party of the second part.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS it is necessary that provision be made for suitable lighting facilities for the Town of Sherwood, Washington County, Oregon, and whereas said party of the first part desires to contract for the term of ten years (10) for the purchase of electric current for lighting or other purposes for said Town,

AND WHEREAS said party of the second part is desirous of selling electric current for lighting and other purposes to said party of the first part for the said part for the siad period of then years,

NOW? THEREFORE in consideration of the premises and in consideration of the premises and covenants hereinafter set out to be performed by each of the parties hereto, it is hereby expressly undersyood and agreed by and between the said parties hereto, as follows, to wit:

Firs t: Said party of the second part hereby agrees to furni he and supply for the period of ten (10) tears from an after April 4th 1913, electric current for lighting and other purposes, to he said party of the first part, at the prices, in the quantities and under the conditions following:

- (a) 20 multiple Tungsten lamps of 100 Watts each, or the equivalent thereof, for the sum of Thirty(\$30.00) per month, payable monthly, but not in advance, on the first of each month,; said lamps to burn from dusk to midnight each night.
- (b) Additional curent shall be furnished inaany quant y or amount requested by said party of the first part, at the rate of \$1.25 per month for each 100 Watt multiple Tungsten malp, or the equivalent thereof, burned from dusk until midnight each night
- (c) If lamps of other capacity than above stated are used by said party of the first part, then the charge and cost for and of said current shall be in porportin to the number of Watts, and at the rate of one and one-fourth cents (\$.01 1/4) per Watt, from dusk until midnight.
- (d) Said party of the second part shall furnish all current that maybe requested by said party of the first part after the hour of midnight, and for such current as may be furnished after said hour of midnight, the charge therefore shall be eight cents (\$.08) per kilowatt hour.

SECOD: Said party of the second part agrees to furnish and keep the voltage of all electrical current purchased under the this contract at such voltage as will give and afford a good commercial light in each and every lamp used by said party of the first part, and to AXX at all times funish as much electrical current as the said party of the first part may request or require.

THIRD: Said party of the first part hereby expressly agrees to purchase electrical current for not less that 20 multiple Tungsten lamps, of 100 Watts eah, or the equivale nt thereof, for the period of ten (10) years from and after April 4 h 1913, and to paytherefor the totalsum of \$30 per month, payable monthly on the first dayof each month; said lamps to burn from dusk until midnight each night. Said party of the first part

hereby further expressly agres to pay for any additional current used for street lighting purposes the amounts herein before set out, in accordance withthe conditions herein before mentioned, and it is expresslyagreed and understood that the prices herein mentioned shall apply only to current used for steet lighting purposes.

chase all of the electrical current used or to be use by it for street lighting or other purposes during said period of ten years, from said party of the second part. Said party of the fir part further expressly agree to buy and purchase noelectrical current for lighting or other purposes fom any other person, firm orcorporation, during said period of ten (10) years, other than from the said party of the second part.

FIFTH: This Agrement shall take effect and be considered in force from and after ahe fourth day of April 1913.

IN WINESSWHEROF the partyof the first part has caused this agreement to be executed in duplicate by the President of is Council, and bythe Town Recorder, thereunto duly authorized; and the partyof the second part has hereunto set his h and and seal to fluplicates hereof, this fourth day of April 1913.
