

Ordinance No. 62.
An ordinance Granting of franchise.

The people of the town of Sherwood do ordain as follows:

Section 1.
Authority and permission is hereby granted "Tualatin Valley Electric Company" an Oregon corporation, its successors or assigns, of Sherwood, Washington, State of Oregon, to erect and maintain poles along any and all of the streets and alleys and public thoroughfares of the Town of Sherwood, Oregon provided they shall in no wise interfere with the poles and wires of any and all others companies now doing business and operating within the corporate limits of the town of Sherwood.

Section #2
The rights and privileges and franchise hereby granted shall continue and be in full force unto the said Tualatin Valley Electric Company, its successors or assigns for a period of twenty one years (21) from the date of the passage of this ordinance, unless forfeited by the proper authorities as hereinafter provided.

Section #3.
IT is hereby expressly provided, that any refusal or neglect on the part of said Tualatin Valley Electric Company, its successors or assigns, to furnish at the Town of Sherwood, electric current of such voltage as will give a good commercial light, within the corporate limits of said town, or failure to comply with the requirements of this ordinance or any of the provisions of same, or any other ordinance in pursuance hereof, shall be deemed a forfeiture of the rights and privileges herein granted, and it shall be lawful for the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood to declare by ordinance the forfeiture of the same, and to cause the said wires poles, or other means of conducting said current to be removed from the streets, alleys, and public thoroughfares of the Town of Sherwood Oregon, provided however, that should the service fail through act of God, accident, or other causes beyond the control of the Tualatin Valley Electric Company, such failure shall not be used as a basis for the for the revocation or forfeiture of the rights and privileges granted in this franchise.

Section #4.
The poles to be erected by the Tualatin Valley Electric Company, shall stand at least twenty feet in height from the ground to the cross arms, and shall be placed alongside of the streets, alleys and public thoroughfares at such places as the Town Marshall or Street Commissioner may designate, and the poles when set, and wires when strung, shall at all times be kept free from obstructing the streets, alleys and public thoroughfares.

Section #5.
That Ordinance No. 56, and all other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance is and the same are hereby repealed.
