

ORDINANCE NO 20

An Ordinance to regulate minors after certain hours from places of Business, Streets, or Alleys within the Town of Sherwood, Oregon, and fixing penalty.

The PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section #1

That no person under the age of sixteen years shall be permitted to loiter in places of business, or wander about the streets, alleys or public parks of the Town after the hour of 8 o'clock at night for each and every night during the months of September, October, November, December, January, and February, or after the hour of 9 o'clock at night during the remainder of each year unless such person shall have the permission in writing, of his or her parent or guardian and or shall be accompanied by such parent or guardian; and it is hereby made the duty of the Town Marshall to warn all such persons by causing some bell of the Town to be rung at fifteen minutes to 8 o'clock at night, each and every night during the months of September, October, November, December, January and February, and at fifteen minutes to 9 o'clock at night each and every night during the remainder of each year.

Section #2.

All persons who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance and upon conviction thereof before the Town Recorder shall be punished for the first offence by a public reprimand, to be administered by the Recorder and for each succeeding offence by a fine not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$10.00, and cost of the action; and in all cases where such persons shall ~~fail to~~ fail to pay any fine imposed upon him or her under the provisions of this section, he or she shall be imprisoned on day for every \$2.00 of such fine.
