

ORDINANCE NO. 22.

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION OF PROPERTY ENDANGERED BY THE SALE OR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS.

That people of the Town of Sherwood do ordain as follows:-

SECTION NO. 1. That it shall be unlawful for any firm corporation or individual to sell, give away or caused to be sold or given away, fire-crackers, torpedoes, rockets, bombs, or any other fire works charged with powder or any other explosive, within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood.

Section No. 11. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge or fire any fireworks, fire-crackers, torpedoes, rockets, bombs, or any other fireworks charged with powder or any other explosive within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood, Oregon.

Section No. 111. Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction before the Town Recorder be punished by a fine of not less than ~~\$5.00~~ or more than \$10.00 or in default of payment of such fine then by imprisonment in the Town Jail not less than 31/2 days or more than 5 days.
