An ordinance prescribing the rates to be charged for the use and supply of water from the Town mains:

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SSHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

S E C T I O N 1.

The rates for the use and supply of water under Flat rate Classification from the Town mains be and hereby are prescribed as follows:

BASE RATE, FOR HOT AND COLD WATER FAUCET IN SAME LOCATION:

Residences, Private	\$1.40

If two businesses carrying same Base Rate be operated in Conjunction, the rate shall be one and one half the regular base rate.

The above rates contemplate only necessary use, and if a customer persists in abusing such privileges, the Water Board may wave the base rate and install a meter for such customer. Or in leu of the base rate the customer may have a meter installec at his own expense.

SECTION 11.

That the rates for the use and supply of water through meter from the Town mains shall apply to the following consumers:

The Water Board may make exception to the above classification, when in their judgement the instillation of a meter is not practical, and a flat rate agreed upon satisfactory to the consumer and Water Board.

FOLLOWING RATES WILL APPLY TO ALL METERED CUSTOMERS:

First	150 Cubic feet, or less	Minimum Charge
Next	1000 " " , or less20 cts, per 100 Cu.ft.
Next	10,000 " " , or less15 cts. per 100 Cu.ft.
Excess,	" " 7 cts.per 100 Cu.ft.

SECTION 111.

That the rates for the use and supply of water for sprinkling and irrigation purposes from the Town mains, and the time for such use and supply, be and hereby are prescribed as follows:

Each lot of 50 ft. frontage, by 100 ft. deep or less - per season \$4.00
 Each additional front foot - per season \$.06
 This rate shall also apply to business houses, with exception of hours for sprinkling.

HOURS FOR RESIDENCES:

6 P. M. to 8 P. M. Daily

HOURS FOR BUSINESS HOUSES:

8 A.M. to 9 A.M. (Daily.
 3 P.M. to 4 P.M. (

Payment for season, four months, in advance, commencing with June 1st.

Water accounts three months in arrears are subject to being disconnected and a charge of \$2.50 will be made for turning same on upon payment of the delinquent bill.
