

ORDINANCE No. 70.

An Ordinance for making street improvements on the street extending north and south between Blocks 1 and 2 on the west and Blocks 3 and 4 on the east, in Sherwood Acres, all in said City of Sherwood, Oregon, said improvement to begin at the north end of said street at the southerly line of the County Road extending along the northwesterly side of said Blocks 1 and 2 and to extend to the end of said street at the south boundary line of said Sherwood Acres, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Sherwood does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Street extending north and south between Blocks 1 and 2, on the west, and Blocks 3 and 4, on the east, in Sherwood Acres, said improvement to begin at the north end of said street at the southerly line of the County Road Extending along the northwesterly side of said Blocks 1 and 2, and to extend to the end of said street at the south boundary line of said Sherwood Acres, all in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, be improved by bringing the surface of said street to the proper subgrade, paving the roadway with macadam pavement 14 feet wide and of an approximate thickness of .5 feet, providing suitable drainage, and by doing such other improvement work as will make a proper and appropriate improvement.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of such improvement work be assessed against the lots, tracts or parcels of land abutting upon that said street so improved, and that such work be done in the manner prescribed in this ordinance and as provided by the charter of said City.

Section 3. That the City Engineer of said City be and he is hereby directed to estimate the whole cost and expense of said improvement, as prescribed by the charter of said City, and report such estimate to this City Council.

Section 4. Inasmuch as the above mentioned street improvement is necessary for the public convenience, health peace and safety of said City, and it is necessary that the same be done without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
