An Ordinance declaring and assessing upon each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon 2nd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southerly line of the tract of land formerly known as the John Smith tract, said line being also the southerly boundary line of Smock Addition to Sherwood, its proportionate share of the estimated costs and expenses of the improvement of said portion of 2nd Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 77, of said City, entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on 2nd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southerly line of the tract of land formerly known as the John Smith tract, said leine being also the southerly boundary line of Smock Addition to Sherwood, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed against the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency."

passed by the City Council of said City and approved by the Mayor thereof, on July 27, 1925, and directing that the said assessed cost be entered in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the Charter of said City, and declaring an emergency.

That each lot, tract or parcel of land abutting upon 2nd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the southeasterly line of Main Street to the southerly line of the tract of land formerly ewaed known as the John Smith tract, said line being also the southerly boundary line of Smock Addition to Sherwood, be and the same is hereby assessed with its proportionate share of the estimated costs and expenses of the improvement of said 2nd Street from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southerly line of the tract of land formerly known as the John Smith tract, said line being also the southerly boundary line of Smock Addition to Sherwood,, as provided by Ordinance No. 77, of said City, entitled "An Ordinance for making street improvements on 2nd Street, in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, from the northeasterly line of Main Street to the southerly line of the tract of land formerly known as the John Smith tract,, said line being also the southerly boundary line of Smock Addition to Sherwood, prescribing the character of materials to be used, providing that the costs and expenses of said improvement be assessed agaisnt the property benefitted thereby, and declaring an emergency,"
