



URA Resolution 2006-002

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REPAINTING OF DOWNTOWN STREETScape
FIXTURES AND FURNISHINGS**

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded in August 2005 to Kodiak Bengé of Tualatin, OR for the Downtown Streetscape Improvements – Phase A;

WHEREAS, Kodiak Bengé has now installed blue fixtures and furnishings in the Old Town area;

WHEREAS, the City Council has received varied and diverse input from citizens and business owners regarding the color of the newly installed street fixtures and furnishings;

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the color of the street fixtures and furnishings as they relate to the new image being created for Old Town; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has further considered the color of these furnishings as they relate to the citywide signage (Wayfinding Project).

WHEREAS, staff has received an estimate of \$50,000.00, from the contractor, to repaint the fixtures and furnishings black.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE URBAN RENEWAL DISTRICT BOARD RESOLVES AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The District Administrator is authorized to negotiate with Kodiak Bengé to repaint the street fixtures and furnishings black.

Section 2. The funding source will be the Urban Renewal District Downtown Streetscape Project Contingency Fund.

Section 3. This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Urban Renewal District Board of Directors.
