

When the City Records were delivered by Floyd Shoop in Jan. 1955, Ordinances did not appear to be numbered consecutively; they were not filed numerically; indicating that some were missing. Therefore, it was deemed advisable to begin with Number 500.

No. 500 - Water, water meters, charge for connections and authority to discontinue service. Passed April 1, 1955.

No. 501 - Amendment of City Charter referred to voters by City Council, Authorizing maintenance, repair, operation, etc., of water system, authorizing issuance of \$15,000.00 revenue and general credit bonds for water system purposes. Passed May 27, 1955.

No. 502 - An Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of water bonds in the amount of \$15,000.00.
