ORDINANCE NO. 201

An ordinance fixing charges for sewer service; collection of charges; prescribing of penalties and alternative methods of collection; disposition of funds collected; directing the City Recorder to give notice of ordinance; and declaring an emergency.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

Pursuant to the authority contained in Section 95-1808 and Section 95-1809, Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated (Laws of 1933, Chapter 289, Sections 1 and 2, pages 458 and 459), the following rates and charges are hereby prescribed, ordered and required to be paid for the use of City of Sherwood public sewers, sewer systems, sewage disposal basins, public septic tanks and all other sewer appurtenances thereunto belonging, by each and every person, firm or corporation whose premises are in any manner served thereby, or upon subsequent service thereto, to-wit:

The monthly charge for sewer service shall be equivalent to and at the rate of 30 per centum of the total monthly charge for water service as billed to each such person, firm or corporation; said charge and rate is hereby declared to be just and equitable.

Section 2

Said monthly charge against each and every person, firm or corporation for use of the City's sewage facilities, computed as set forth in Section 1 hereof, shall be due, payable and collected without discount each month on the date, at the time and place and in the same manner in which similar monthly charges for water service are due, payable and collected; provided that the first monthly charge shall be for the month of April 1948, payable May 1, 1948.

Section 3

If such monthly sewer service charge be not paid when due on the date as provided in Section 2 hereof, and within 30 days thereafter, the amount thereof shall be increased by a 10 per centum delinquency penalty, which penalty shall be added to the monthly sewer service charge otherwise due.

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Section 4

If any monthly sewer service charge or charges falling due, together with any penalty assessed as prescribed in Section 3 hereof, be not paid as in Section 2 hereof provided, all amounts in arrears may be recovered by an action at law, or may be certified by the City Council to the County Tax Assessor of Washington County, and be by him assessed against the premises serviced and shall thereupon be collected and paid over in the same manner as other taxes are certified, assessed, collected and paid over.

Section 5

All amounts collected hereunder shall be deposited by the City Treasurer into the Sewer account of the General Fund of the City of Sherwood, Oregon.

Section 6

The City Recorder is hereby directed to give notice of this ordinance and the charges and rates herein provided by publishing same in not less than two successive weekly issues of the Sherwood Valley News and also by posting written or printed copies in not less than four public places in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, both said publications and postings to be accomplished not later than 15 days after approval of this ordinance by the mayor.

Section 7

Inasmuch as there is no existing ordinance prescribing rates and charges for the use of the City's existing sewage facilities, and further that it is imperative for the peace, health, and safety of the people of Sherwood that financial provision be made immediately for the construction, equipping, operation and improvement of sewage facilities, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon April 1, 1948, after its passing by the City Council and its approval by the Mayor.
