ORDINANCE NO. 503

An ordinance prescribing charge for water connections and meters installed outside the corporate limits and further prescribing a charge for each sewer connection within er-eutside the corporate limits with exceptions, and prescribing an emergency.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

No connections to the water mains of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, outside the city limits shall be authorized for any purpose whatsoever unless a prior application, in such form as the City Council shall prescribe, has been filed with the Water Department of the city and the applicant notified of the approval thereof.

For each connection to the water mains of theCity of Sherwood outside the corporate limits not covered by existing contracts, an approved type water meter shall be installed at the time that the water connection is accomplished. The following rates shall be charged:

For each connection to the water system of the City (a) of Sherwood outside the corporate limits, \$100.00;

(b) For each meter installed, \$50.00.

Such charges shall be paid promptly prior to or at the time of installation and before water service is initiated to such user.

Section 2

Cheeled by Orderson & No connection to the sewer system of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, within or outside the corporate limits thereof shall be made unless a prior written application therefor has been filed with the City Recorder and a permit issued authorizing such connection.

A charge of \$75.00 for each sewer connection within the corporate limits shall be paid over to the city prior to the issuance of a permit for such connection. With respect to any sewer connection hereafter made to property within the corporate limits, there shall be allowed as a credit against said charge of \$75.00

all amounts heretofore paid for sewer service by the applicant for such connection with respect to said property. Such credit in no case to exceed the sum of \$75.00 and to be credited only with respect to the service of an individual dwelling or business structure present on such premises as of July 1, 1955.

Inasmuch as there is no existing ordinance prescribing water service and sewer charges as hereinabove set forth, and it is imperative for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, that provision be made for the prompt assessment of charges, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passing by the City Council and approval of the Mayor of the City of Sherwood, Oregon.
