

ORDINANCE No. 508

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF DOGS IN THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any owner or keeper of any dog or dogs in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, to allow or permit such dog or dogs to run at large on the streets, alleys or highways in the City of Sherwood, Oregon, unless accompanied by the owner or keeper of such dog or dogs.

Section 2. Any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon the conviction thereof be punished by a fine not exceeding the sum of \$50.00.

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance was submitted to a vote of the electors at a Special Election held on June 12, 1959, at which Election this ordinance carried by a large majority; and, as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Sherwood, an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
