

ORDINANCE NO. 524

An ORDINANCE authorizing and approving an amendment to City Ordinance No. 402 of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, and to change a specific area from a Residential Zone to the Business Zone and declaring an emergency.

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 402, passed by the City Council of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, on the 3rd day of December, 1948, regulating, classifying and restricting the location of buildings, trades, and industries, and the location of buildings designed, erected or altered for specified property in the city of Sherwood, Oregon, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Zone 2, Business. In addition to the area herein described, there shall be deleted from Residential District No. 1, Zone 1, and included in Zone 2, Business, the following described area: Block 6, Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Smockville Addition, City of Sherwood, bounded by Pine Street, Second Street and Washington Street to the alley of said Block.

Section 2. Whereas, it is imperative for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Sherwood, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and approval.
