ORDINANCE NO. 534

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4^(a) OF ORDINANCE No. 514 with
RESPECT TO WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND CHARGES THEREFOR

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 4^(a) of Ordinance No. 514 enacted on May 5, 1961
be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Section 4:^(a) Water service connections^{and}/charges

(1) The following connection fees shall be paid in advance
and shall accompany the written application for water service
when filed with the city:

(a) For water service connection within the city limits:

1. A connection charge in the sum of \$50.00
2. A sum equal to the cost of all materials, including meter, meter box, valve, together with labor for installation of that portion of the water service facilities lying between the curb line and meter box connection.

(b) For water service connection outside the city limits:

1. A connection charge in the sum of \$500⁰⁰
2. A sum equal to the cost of all materials, including meter, meter box, valve, together with labor for installation of that portion of the water service facilities lying between the curb line and meter box connection.

(c) In all cases involving an extension of existing trunk water lines within a street or public way, the applicant must pay all costs of materials, labor and installation for such extension of the line in addition to the charges imposed under sub-sections (a) and (b) above."


~~Section~~ (2:) From and after the effective date of this ordinance, no connections to the city's water system outside the corporate limits of the city of Sherwood shall be authorized or permitted except as the City Council shall approve and authorize by ordinance."

Section 2: Effective date

Inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Sherwood, to assure a continued supply of water and water service, and to protect the city's revenues for such purposes, it is declared that an emergency exists, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the mayor.


PASSED: By Unanimous vote of all council members present, after being read by title twice, and read in sections and in full upon its third reading, this 21st day of Feb February, 1964.
