Subject: Reasons for repeal of ordinances

The ordinances listed below have been reviewed by the city council and other city officers. Their comments and suggestions for repealing these eighteen ordinances are included in the following list:

Ordinance No. 1 dated 12/5/13, relating to offenses, is covered by new offenses ordinance.

Ordinance No. 4 dated 12/5/13, relating to disorderly houses, is covered by new offenses ordinance.

Ordinance No. 5 dated 12/5/13, relating to fires on streets, is superseded by Ordinance No. 528.

Ordinance No. 7 dated 12/6/13, relating to fire apparatus, is superseded by Ordinance No. 528.

Ordinance No. 8 dated 12/5/13, relating to cattle at large, is covered by new offenses ordinance.

Ordinance No. 10 dated 12/5/13, relating to bicycles on sidewalk, is covered by new traffic ordinance.

Ordinance No. 12 dated 12/5/13, relating to working prisoners, is covered by new offenses ordinance.

Ordinance No. 14 dated 12/5/13, relating to traffic regulations, is covered by new traffic ordinance.

Ordinance No. 20 dated 6/5/14, relating to curfew, is superseded by Ordinance No. 527.

Ordinance No. 22 dated 9/4/14, relating to fireworks, is superseded by Ordinance No. 528.

Ordinance No. 46 dated 12/6/20, relating to garbage regulations, is covered by new nuisances ordinance.

Ordinance No. 101 dated 10/24/27, relating to liquor regulations, is superseded by Ordinance No. 529.

Ordinance No. 102 dated 10/24/27, relating to drunk on streets, is covered by new offenses ordinance.

Ordinance No. 104 dated 2/3/28, relating to traffic regulations, is covered by new traffic ordinance.

Ordinance No. 107 dated 8/2/29, relating to nuisances, is covered by new nuisances ordinance.

Ordinance No. 140 dated 5/10/43, relating to burning regulations, is superseded by Ordinance No. 528.
