ORDINANCE No. 537

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF SEWER BONDS OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$175,000.00 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, an amendment to the Charter of the City of Sherwood, adding a new section numbered 256(c), authorizing the construction, reconstruction, repair, operation and maintenance of sewer disposal facilities and a sewer system, both within and outside the corporate limits of said city, and authorizing a bond issue to finance the same, and calling a special election for the purpose of submitting the proposed charter amendment to the voters, was passed by the City Council of Sherwood on the 10th day of May, 1963, designated "Ordinance No. 522", and said proposed charter amendment was duly and regularly submitted to the voters at an election held in said city on thellth day of June, 1963, and of the total of 111 votes cast, 95 ballots were in favor, and 16 ballots were against said charter amendment, and thus a clear majority of the voters favored the said charter amendment and the issuance of bonds in the sum of not to exceed \$220,000.00 for the purposes above stated; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said authorization of the legal voters and to meet the deadline established by the federal government with respect to participation by way of federal grant in the cost of said sewer system and disposal facilities, it is necessary that immediate action be taken to offer \$175,000.00 of said bonds for sale to provide funds wherewith to defray the cost thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That general obligation sewer bonds of the City of Sherwood, Oregon shall be issued in serial form in the total sum of \$175,000.00 in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, to be designated "Sewer Bonds - Series 1964", and running consecutively

Said bonds shall bear interest at a rate to be fixed by the City Council when same are sold, and not to exceed 6% per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of June and December of each year as evidenced by the coupons to be attached thereto; both principal and interest on said bonds shall be payable at the office of the City Treasurer of the City of Sherwood, Sherwood, Oregon.

Said bonds shall be subject to redemption on the first day of June, 1969, or on any semi-annual interest payment date thereafter upon notice duly given in accordance with Section 253 of the Charter of the City of Sherwood and applicable statutes.

Section 2: All bonds shall be sold at par plus accrued interest from date thereof to date of delivery, and all bonds shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Recorder of the City of Sherwood, Oregon, and the coupons attached thereto shall bear the facsimile signatures of the said officers of the City.

Section 3: The full faith and credit of the City of Sherwood, Oregon shall be and is hereby pledged to each successive holder of each of said bonds for the prompt and punctual payment of the principal and interest thereof as and when same shall become due, and in addition thereto, the City of Sherwood, Oregon hereby covenants and agrees with each successive holder of each of said bonds and coupons, that the City of Sherwood does pledge to the payment thereof the net revenue derived from the operation and use of the City's sewer systems and the sale of sewer service therefrom subject only to pre-existing outstanding sewer bonds and the requirements for payment thereof.

Section 4: That all bonds shall be registered in the Bond Register of the City of Sherwood, Oregon by the Treasurer of said City.

This bond is one of a series of like date and tenor, except as to maturity dates, aggregating \$175,000.00, numbered 1 to 175, both inclusive, authorized and issued by the City of Sherwood, Oregon pursuant to Sections 287.002 to 287.012, inclusive, Oregon Revised Statutes, and is issued under and pursuant to authority of amendment to the City Charter of the City of Sherwood, Oregon proposed and submitted to the legal voters of said City by the City Council

legal votes cast at said election, and it is hereby certified that all acts, conditions and things required to be done precedent to the issuance of this bond have been duly and legally done as required by law, that the aforesaid charter amendment authorized the issuance and sale of this bond and that this bond is within every date and other limitation provided by the constitution and laws of the State of Oregon and the charter of the City of Sherwood, and for the punctual payment of principal and interest thereof, the full faith and credit of the City of Sherwood, Oregon are hereby irrevocably pledged.

Any or all bonds of this series maturing after June 1, 1969 are subject to redemption at par plus accrued interest in numerical order on the 1st day of June, 1969 or on any semi-annual interest due date thereafter, at the option of the City of Sherwood, and upon publication of notice of redemption by said City as provided by Section 253 of the Charter of the City of Sherwood and applicable statutes.

Under the provisions of the Charter of the City of Sherwood, and ordinances enacted thereunder, the City of Sherwood shall keep and maintain such rates and charges for the use of the sewer system of said City as will provide revenues sufficient at all times to pay the costs of operation and maintenance of said sewer system and to pay the interest and principal of this Series - 1964 Sewer Bonds authorized by said amendment to the City Charter, in addition to the requirements for payment of all other issues of sewer bonds of said City, and the entire net revenues of said sewer system shall be deposited in a separate account known as "Sewer Bond Fund", and the net revenue thereof is hereby pledged to the payment of the series of bonds of which this bond is one of 175, subject only to the requirements for payment of pre-existing bonds of similar character heretofore issued and outstanding.

All of the net operating revenues derived from the sewer system of the City of Sherwood shall be utilized to pay interest charges and serial maturities of principal of said bond issue, subject only to the requirements of principal and interest of pre-existing outstanding bonds of said City with respect to which said revenues have heretofore been pledged. Net operating revenues are hereby defined as the gross operating revenues from the City sewer system, less operating and maintenance expenses thereof.

Section 9: It is hereby declared and adjudged that existing conditions are such that the immediate enactment of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Sherwood, Oregon to avoid serious disruption of sewer service within said City, and it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and that this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
