AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 514 WITH RESPECT TO WATER SERVICE TO USERS BOTH WITHIN AND OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY AND FIXING CHARGES THEREFOR.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 514 of the City of Sherwood, enacted by the City Council on the 5th day of May, 1961, and set forth in the General Ordinances of theCity of Sherwood, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. Rates to Be Charged.

"(a) In-city rates. The following monthly rates shall be charged every customer for the use of the city water within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood:

First 4,000 gallons or less

per month

\$2.25

Next 26,000 gallons per month
Next 70,000 gallons per month
Over 100,000 gallons per month
.25 per 1000 gallons
.20 per 1000 gallons
.15 per 1000 gallons

"(b) Out-of-city rates. The following rates shall be charged all persons, firms (and) corporations for the use of the 104 Per M water supplied without the corporate limits of the City of over min. Sherwood, excepting those under special contract:

> First 4,000 gallons or less \$3.50 per month.

Next 26,000 gallons per month
Next 70,000 gallons per month
Over 100,000 gallons per month
.40 per 1000 gallons
.30 per 1000 gallons
.20 per 1000 gallons

Farmers or Trucks, for special purposes 1.00 per 1000 gallons

Water to Water Districts will be sold at the rate of .00088 per gallon with a minimum of \$5.00 per month.

- "(c) Submeters. Where a water meter or meters are used to measure the total water used, as for water districts or out-of-city group customers, and where a meter is used to measure the total water used, as in apartment houses, the City will not furnish or read auxiliary or submeters used for the customer's convenience.
- "(d) Nonregistering meters. The customer shall be charged for water consumed while the meter is not registering. The charge shall be at the minimum monthly meter rate or will be computed upon an estimate of consumption based either upon the customer's prior use during the same season

of the year or upon a reasonable comparison with the use of other customers receiving the same class of service during the same period and under similar circumstances and conditions."

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 514 as passed by the City Council on May 5, 1961 in all respects other than as herein expressly amended, be, and the same is hereby, continued in full force and effect.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be effective on and after the 31st day from the date of its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
