AN ORDINANCE CONEIRMING AND RATTPYTMG TRE PESOLUTTONS OF THE CIMY COUNCIL OF JUNE 21, 1968, AND JULY 9, 1969, TIPA RESPECT CO WR HALL STREET SEMER IMPROVENETT AND ASSESSMGTT DISTRICT; APPROVIMG, RATIEYTMG AND ADOPMTNG PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS AMD BSTIMATES FOR CONGSRUCTION OF SAFITARY SEMER SYSTEMS, DECLARING RESULTS OF HEARTMG WELD WITH FESPECT THEPETO, DIRECTING SOLICITATION OF EIDS FOR COMSTRUCTION OF HALL STREET SANITARY SEWER SYSTET, PROVIDING FOR THE MARING OF SAID IMPROVEIENT AND DECLARING AN ERERGEMCY.

Wheras, a resolution was duly passed by the city Council or the city or Sherwood at its special meeting of Junc 2t, 1960, a copy Whereof is hereto attached and by this reference made a part hereof to the same legal force and crect as if set forth herein in rull, oy the tems of which boundaries of a proposed sever improvement district vere aescribed, and the Coumcil declared its intention to construct $\equiv$ senitary semer system and to assess the costs thereof against the property within the boundaries specially benefitted, and

WHREAS, oy the tems or said resolution a heamine was duly called to be neld in the council Chambers, in the City Fall at Sherwood, Oreacn, on the loth day of July, 1968, at the hour of 8 o'cloc: p.n. for the purpose of afforaing an opportunity to any parties ayerieved oy the proposal to make objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvement, and
mheres, pursuant to said resolution, due and legal notice on said hearing was given by publication in the Tri-City mimes for two consecutive publishings on June 27,1968 and July 4,1968 , and three copies of said resolution were posted in three public and conspicuous places within said proposed sewer improvement and assessment distriot not less than ten days prior to said hearing; and

MEREAS, said hearing was duly and regulariy conducted at City fiall, Bherwood, Oregon, on July 10, 1968, at the hour of 8 o:cec. p.m. whereat certain persons appeared and were heard, and said hearana was by unanimous motion continued indefinitely, for the purpose of aifording further opportunity to any parties aggrieved by the proposel to make objections or remonstrances to the proposed improvenent, end

WHEREAB, a resolution was duly passed by the Council at its regular meeting of July 9, 1969, a copy whereor is attached hereto End by this reference made a part hereof to the same legal force and efrect as if set forth herein in full, by the tems of which the Council reaficmed its intention to proceed with the formation of the sanitamy sewer improvement and assessment district, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of said resolution of July $\mathscr{G}$, 1969, a hearing was called to be held in the City Fall, City of Sherwood, on the 6th day of August, 1969, at the hour of 8 o'cloc: p.m. and pursuant to said resolution, due and legal notice of saic continued hearing was given by publication in the Tri-City Times for two consecutive publishines on July 17,1969 , and July 24, 1969, price
to said hearing and three copies of said resolution were posted in three public and conspicuous places within said proposed sewer improvement and assessment district not less than ten days prior to said hearing; and

Whereas, said continued hearing was duly reopened and regularly called to order and held in the City ilall, Sherwood, Oregon, on August 6, 1969, at 8 o'clock $p . m$, whereat certain persons appeared and were heard; and

MEREAS, the City Engineer has submitted to the Council plaras specifications and estimates for the work to be done; and

WHEREAS, due to inflation and risine estimated construction costs, the cost of the work to be done has increased from $\$ 16,000$ to $\$ 25,000$, and the City Engineer has summitted to the Council a statement of the lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefitted, and the total cost of the improvements which each of such lote, parts of lots and parcels of land shall pay on account of the benefits to be derived, and

Wharkas, the City Council finds that such plans, opeciêcatione and estimates are satisfactory, and

WhFFAB, all proceedings to date havebeen in confomity ait: Section 223.387, Oregon Revisea Statutes, and Chapter XUT, Charter of the City of Sherwood, and all the procedures were regulerly ard lawfully conducted,

Section 1: mat all matters set forth in the resolution of the chtu Council of Shervood, Orecon, of June 21,1960 , s copy Whereof is hereto attached, marked Bxibit "A" and by reference nemoin made a part hereor to the same legal force and effect as if set forth nerein in full, be and the same are hereby approved, ratifie: and confimed and the boundaries of the area known as the fall Stret. Sewer Improvement District as heretorore described in said resoiut on and as described or the attached sheet heaued "Description" be, and the same are hereby, declared and fixed in accoraance with said cescription;

Section 2: That the City Council of the City of Sierwood havine acquired jurisdiction to order the improvement to be aca coes hereby authorize and direct the construction of a sanitary se:te: system within the boundaries of said rall Street Improvement Distrac: in confomity in all reasonable particulars with the plans and socolfications submitted to the Council by the City Encineer.

Section 3: That the City Recorder be, and is hereby, dipected to immediately invite proposals for the construction of ain improvements by publication in the Tri-City Times in not less thar two consecutive issues, the last publication to be not less than fove days prior to Qamuary 7 , 1970, at the hour of 8 o'clock $p . .$. which date and time ishereby designated for the opening of bids in the City iall, all proposals to be then and there publicly hearc.

Section 4: That inasmuch as it is necessary for the peace, healt: and safety of the people of the City of Sherwood that the saio improvements be constructed with the least possible dela,
an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this orainance shall become effective upon its passage by the Council and signature by the Mayor.
