

CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED PURSUANT TO OREGON REVISED STATUTES 483.318 PROHIBITING REVERSE OR U-TURNS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 599, CHAPTER IV, SECTION 483.318(S)

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Ordinance 599, Chapter IV, Section 483.318 (S) be, and the same is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the following provisions:

"(5) In addition to the foregoing express prohibitions of this section (Section 483.318 (S)) U-turns or reverse turns shall not be made on any public street or at the intersection within the corporate limits of the City of Sherwood, whether or not the view of said vehicle is obstructed or unobstructed, unless otherwise posted by authority of the City Council.


"(6) Signs shall be placed at the direction of the Chief of Police in a conspicuous manner at or near the corporate limits of the City on all arterial thoroughfares entering the City and at such other places the Chief of Police shall deem necessary for the information of the traveling public, indicating that U-turns are prohibited. The Chief of Police may, pursuant to resolutions of the City Council approving such action, post certain locations where he deems that U-turns or reverse turns may be permitted with caution."

Section 2: This ordinance shall be effective on and after the 31st day from its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor,

PASSED: By the Council by unanimous vote of all Council members present after being read by caption three times and in body once, this 12th. day of September, 1973.
