

ORDINANCE NO. 637

CITY OF SHERWOOD, OREGON

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 600

WHEREAS, there was enacted at the 1973 Legislative Session, Chapter 176 Oregon Laws 1973 (Senate Bill 693) an act requiring curb cuts and ramps for handicapped persons, and

WHEREAS, said specifications for said curb cuts and ramps should be made a part of the City's specifications for the construction of streets and sidewalks,

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 600 be, and the same is hereby, amended by adding thereto Section 8A, reading as follows:

"Section 8A:

"(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the specifications hereinabove adopted in Section 8, the standard for construction of curbs on each side of any city street, or any connecting street for which curbs and sidewalks have been prescribed, shall require not less than two curb cuts or ramps per lineal block to be located on or near the crosswalks at intersections. Each curb cut or ramp shall be at least 30 inches wide at a slope not to exceed one-inch rise per eight-inch run and so constructed as to allow reasonable access to the crosswalk for physically handicapped persons.

"(2) Standards set for curb cuts and ramps under subsection (1) of this section shall apply to all new curb construction and to all replacement curbs constructed at any point in a block which gives reasonable access to a crosswalk."

PASSED: By the Council by unanimous vote of all Council members present after being read by caption three times and in body once, this 10th day of October, 1973.
