AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER VIII, "PARKING REGULATIONS" OF ORDINANCE #599 MOTOR VEHICLE CODE OF THE CITY OF SHERWOOD, BY PROHIBITING PARKING ON A PORTION OF MEINECKE ROAD, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN "15 MINUTE* ZONES, AND LIMITING A PORTION OF MAIN STREET PARKING TO CITY OWNED VEHICLES.

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance #599, Chapter VIII, "Parking Regulations", Section 9(a) is hereby amended and supplemented by adding to said Section 9(a) the following subparagraph:

"(6) On Meinecke Road between the Cedar Creek Bridge and the intersection of Meinecke Road and Lee Drive."

Ordinance 599, Chapter VIII "Parking Regulations", Section 2: Section 9 is amended by adding thereto the following subsection (c):

"(c) For longer than 15 minutes

(1) in one parking space to be designated by sign on the north side of Railroad Street, between the intersections of Main Street and Park Street with said Railroad Street.

(2) in one parking space to be designated by sign on the north side of First Street between the intersections of Pine Street and Washington Street with said First Street.

(3) in one parking space to be designated by sign on the west side of Pine Street between the intersections of Railroad Street and First Street with said Pine Street."

Section 3: Ordinance #599, Chapter VIII, "Parking Regulations", is amended by adding thereto the following section:

No person shall park any motor vehicle "Section 9: except a city owned vehicle on the west side of Main Street, from the intersection of Main Street and First Street to the intersection of the alley between Main and Park Streets with Main Street."

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be effective on the thirtyfirst day after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
