Budget Message

The renewal District was formed in August of 2000. This will represent the first full budget year for the district.

During the opening year of the district, the City loaned the district all funds necessary to begin operations, which the district will repay in 2001- 2002.

The District also plans on issuing its first debt in the amount of \$1.4 million dollars to finance the start up of performing arts in the old town district. This money is intended to support several different structures that will look for grant funding to be completed. The Robin Hood Theater reconstruction project, the Old School Rehab and the Stella Olsen Amp Theater.

The district also plans to hire a full time Urban Renewal District Administrator some time during the year and to pay for a part time performing arts administrator during the year.
