WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal Agency Budget Committee has reviewed and acted on the proposed Urban Renewal Agency budget; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Committee has approved and recommended a balanced budget to the Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors on May 5, 2004; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with State law, the Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors has held a public hearing on the budget as approved and recommended by the Budget Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors desires to adopt the approved budget and carry out the programs identified in the budget;

#### NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Adoption of the 2004-05 Budget. The Urban Renewal Agency Board of Directors of the City of Sherwood, Oregon hereby adopts the budget for the City of Sherwood Urban Renewal Agency for fiscal year 2004-05 in the sum of \$1,327,426, now on file at City Hall.
