SUBJECT: URA Resolution 2005-004 Charlie Harbick – Railroad Street Antique Mall façade Grant

#### Issue

Should the Sherwood Urban Renewal District Board approve a Façade Grant for Charlie Harbick of Railroad Street Antique Mall?

#### **Background**

On March 16, 2005 an application for a Façade Grant was submitted by the owner of the Railroad Antique store in Old Town. SURPAC, the urban renewal advisory committee considered the application at the March 16, 2005 meeting. This façade grant application is the first submitted dealing with façade improvement to the rear façade which is along the alley/future pedestrian pathway in Old Town. SURPAC unanimously recommended approval of the application. In keeping with Goal B of the Urban Renewal Plan - "Rehabilitate Building Stock," Exhibit A is attached to Resolution 2005-004.

This program allows any property owner who uses their building in Old Town for retail or commercial endeavors a source of matching funds from the District (fifty percent (50%) of the overall project cost).

#### Financial Analysis

This program is funded from the District's General Fund. Buildings in Old Town used for retail or commercial endeavors will qualify for grants. The program still remains a matching funds program. The applicant must submit a bill for work completed before any reimbursement will be authorized.

#### Recommendation

MOTION TO APPROVE THE URA Resolution 2005-004, a resolution authorizing the District Board to award a Façade Grant to Charlie Harbick, for the exterior improvements to the Railroad Street Antique Mall building at 260 Railroad Avenue.

## A RESOLUTION APPROVING A FAÇADE GRANT FOR CHARLIE HARBICK AND RAILROAD STREET ANTIQUE MALL

WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal District created the Façade Grant Program by URA Resolution 2003-001 in January 2003 and amended exhibit A approved by the District Board on May 11, 2004; and

WHEREAS, Charlie Harbick and Railroad Street Antique Mall has submitted an application for a grant shown as Exhibit B to this document; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sherwood Urban Renewal Planning and Advisory Commission (SURPAC) concurs with the application and unanimously recommends approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE URBAN RENEWAL DISTRICT BOARD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The District Administrator is authorized to distribute up to the \$15,000 maximum in accordance to the terms and conditions to the Façade Grant Program.

City of Sherwood Urban Renewal District Old Town Facade Program May 2004


**Program Scope** – This program has been proposed to provide a pool of money for the upgrade and renewal of Commercial buildings in the Old Town overlay zone.

Funding Source – This pool of money will be funded entirely by the Urban Renewal District.

Program Guidelines - The following guidelines will be used to administer the Program:

- Any money provided by this program must be used for the exterior upgrade to an
  existing structure located in Old Town. These structures must be used for mixed
  use, or commercial use.
- 2. All dollars provided by this program must be matched by an equal amount of money provided by the applicant.
- 3. All requests for money will be made using a form provided by the District. The full SURPAC Committee or Urban Renewal Board will review each application for support and will award grants based on the project proposed.
- 4. The Program Pool will have \$150,000 and will award grants in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 per grant application.
- 5. Applicants may apply as many times as they wish, however, generally one grant per year per property will be awarded. Exceptions will be made by SURPAC depending on number of applications and amount of money spent for the year.
- 6. Each application will be reviewed by staff and recommended to SURPAC for action. The Board will make the final award by resolution.
- 7. Money up to the grant amount will be awarded with-in 14 days of presentation of a receipt for the project. Each receipt award will be in the amount of 50% of the receipt.
- 8. A \$15,000 matching grant may be provided per street address or per street facing façade. This will depend on the number of applications and amount of money spent for the year.









#### Specific Functions (continued):

- 1. Demolish old roof and install new plywood and ARC 80 type roofing on the new area and the existing storage room. The area covered will be approximately 328 square feet. Install new flashing cut into block wall.
- 2. Frame new walls under existing framework. Will be approximately 248 square feet.
- 3. Install new exterior door. Demolish 1 sliding door and frame in 1 door way.
- 4. Sheath exterior walls with 1/2" plywood.
- 5. Side exterior walls with a board and bat style. Siding is  $4 \times 8$  sheets with  $1 \times 2$ " bats on top. 1/2" plywood to be used as sub siding.
- 6. New electrical wiring to consist of a new meter base. New wiring to clean up old meter and one outside door light.
- 7. Siding to be painted with Miller latex with color to be chosen by owner.
- 8. 41' of new gutter and down spout to be installed.
- 9. Back step to be removed and a new one poured to comply with city code.
- 10. Contractor to obtain permits and plans to submit to City.


