ORDINANCE NO. 764

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE OF PUBLIC SIDEWALKS, BICYCLE PATHS AND PEDESTRIAN FOOTPATHS BY PERSONS RIDING, DRIVING, OR LEADING HORSES, MULES, DONKEYS, OR CATTLE, PROVIDING A PENALTY

THE CITY OF SHERWOOD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. No person shall ride, drive or lead one or more horses, mules, donkeys, or cattle upon any public sidewalk, bicycle path or pedestrian footpath within the City of Sherwood, unless the City Council shall have by resolution first designated the sidewalk, bicycle path, or pedestrian footpath as also being a bridle path.

Section 2. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punishable by a fine of not more than \$250.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon the 31st day after its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
